Thank you for your contribution to the 5th annual Camp Moxie. Your support helped 72 Girl Scouts from all over Southeastern Michigan spend the first week of August finding their passion with friends and mentors at this unique leadership experience.

What the girls had to say about their experiences

Girls ranked the top four things they learned at Camp Moxie that were valuable in helping them pursue their goals:

1. Pitching or selling their ideas to others
2. Finding their passion
3. Using social entrepreneurship and civic action to solve problems
4. Learning the value of creating a vision for the future

Girls agreed that they benefited from Camp Moxie in the following ways:

- **96%** said it influenced their future in a positive way
- **95%** felt more prepared to take action to solve social and civic issues
- **96%** are better team members
- **93%** said they can apply what they learned at Camp Moxie to other areas of life
- **85%** said it helped them to be a leader

Girls and the leadership experience:

Each day, the campers followed the Girl Scouts' Three Keys to Leadership: **Discover, Connect and Take Action.** That meant every day was filled with opportunities for girls to learn, grow and find their Moxie.

"I like how everything has an assigned meaning behind it. It's all much deeper than it looks," said Sara C. This was Sara's second year attending Moxie.
